Our Building Fund pledged income for March was \$9,731.75. We also received \$1,609.00 from Memorial gifts and a bequest of \$5,000.00 from the Maurine Achauer estate.

Our Outreach giving for February was \$1,373.30. These funds were disbursed to Disciples Mission Fund, Ozark Lakes Area, and Johnson County Hospice. We also received \$355.00 for Week of Compassion.

The boiler that heats our church is not working. It will cost approximately \$1,600.00 for the parts to repair the boiler, and the funds for this will use some of the budgeted funds originally allotted for other work in the church. Due to this budget constraint, we will only be able to do the basic landscaping work at the front of the church for this year.

Septagon has been working to repair the leaks from our roof, and we hope this will take care of our water problems

The new "No Parking" signs will soon be installed on the north lot. The signs state the lot is to only be used for Farmer's Market activities and for our church activities; they had been removed over the winter months.

We will be installing a spotlight on the Chalice on the front of the Christian Life Center.

Our lawnmower needs some maintenance work. We also plan to do some cleaning in the garage.

Our church will host the next Ozark Lakes Area Board Meeting on May 23 at 3:30 p.m.; this will include a meal for the attendees. We encourage a good participation from our members.

The Christian Women's Fellowship ladies recently visited our shut-ins. Following the visits, the ladies traveled to Lee's Summit for lunch and a visit at Cockrell.
