Through the largest global alliance of Christian humanitarian agencies, Action by Churches Together (ACT), Week of Compassion is already on the ground in Haiti. General Briefing

From the earliest New Testament days, people evidenced their belief in God and their acceptance of Jesus Christ through a simple confession of faith. It was an act of commitment to faith, fellowship, witness and service. The essence of that ancient act has remained unchanged through twenty centuries. Becoming a member of the Christian Church today is not unlike the New Testament experience. One is required to make a public profession of faith, be baptized, and accept the responsibility and joy of commitment.

Disciples’ Traditions: The Confession of Faith

Jesus asked of the apostle Peter, “Who do you say that I am?” and Simon Peter responded, “You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.” This profound confession became the model by which all generations of Christians have expressed their faith.

Like generation upon generation before, you stand alone in front of the fellowship of Disciples and listen to the ageless invitation of the pastor, “Do you believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God, and do you accept Him as Lord of your life?” With peace, firmness, and commitment, you respond, “I do!” With that profession, your Christian life begins.

You have agreed in this act to receive the active influence of Christ in your life. You have resolved to trust in the will of Christ. Your loyalty is pledged and henceforward Christ reigns supreme in your mind and soul.
